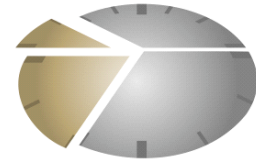


Case Study: 1-on-1 training

Slivers-of-Time working is for anyone with spare hours to sell to local employers.



SLIVERS-OF-TIME WORKING: Case Study	
BUYER	London Connects
REQUIREMENT	Trainers to teach individuals how to use a PC and access the Internet then start to sell their Slivers-of-Time.
Traditional fulfilment	Hire trainers from a local college or training provider
Slivers-of-Time route	Induct a pool of 15 existing established Slivers-of-Time sellers. Certify them in how to teach basic PC Skills. Offer each trainee up to 5 one hour, personalised sessions at a time and place with public internet access of their choosing.

	Traditional route	Slivers-of-Time route
Method of training	The traditional method of training groups of individuals is on a one to many basis (classroom style) .	Residents are able to select a suitable time to receive training around their other commitments and seller trainers can be booked to match this availability.
Opportunity for employment	No. of people employed: 1	15 sellers sell their hours in this way
Impact on local employment	Negligible	Work is spread out across local Newham sellers, all of whom are not only earning extra money, but gaining invaluable experience in training and engaging with individuals on a one to one basis, developing communication and interpersonal skills as part of their employability development.
