

'9 to 5 not working'

BRITAIN'S economy could be under threat unless there is a "work revolution", the Tories warned yesterday.

Shadow work and pensions secretary Phillip Hammond called for the nine-to-five job to be ditched, and replaced by flexitime, job-sharing and working from home.

He said people should work for more than one firm, selling "slivers of time" to various employers, in a speech in Stratford, East London.
